## EXEMPTION TRANSPONDER CARRIAGE IN TMZ FOR NON-MOTORISED HANGGLIDERS AND PARAGLIDERS

### 1 — INTRODUCTION

With effect from 11 March 2010 the 3rd phase of the mandatory transponder carriage for non-motorised aircraft has been implemented. In the 3rd phase the lower limit of the transponder mandatory zones (TMZ) is 1200 ft AMSL from MON-FRI 0800-1600 (0700-1500), EXC HOL. This circular is an addition to, and should be read in conjunction with, AIC-A 07/08.

### 2 — EXEMPTION NON-MOTORISED HANGGLIDERS AND PARAGLIDERS

Non-motorised hanggliders and paragliders are, MON-FRI 0800-1600 (0700-1500) EXC HOL, exempted from the mandatory transponder carriage in the following parts of the TMZs:

TMZ A	FL 045 1200 ft AMSL
TMZ B	FL 045 1200 ft AMSL
TMZ C	FL 045 1200 ft AMSL
TMZ D	<u>2500 ft AMSL</u> 1200 ft AMSL
TMZ E	FL 045 1200 ft AMSL
TMZ Eelde	<u>1500 ft AMSL</u> 1200 ft AMSL
TMZ G1	FL 045 1200 ft AMSL
TMZ Maastricht	<u>1500 ft AMSL</u> 1200 ft AMSL
TMZ Rotterdam	<u>2500 ft AMSL</u> 1200 ft AMSL

Detailed information on the 3rd phase of the mandatory transponder carriage and the TMZs is published in the revised AIC-A 07/08.
